



U.S.-Colombia Trade Agreement:

U.S.-COLOMBIA TRADE AGREEMENT WILL:

Create jobs for U.S. workers

- This is an economic stimulus plan that will generate U.S. jobs.

End unfair taxing of American goods sent to Colombia

- Exports of U.S. manufactured goods to Colombia face average tariffs of 11% while most Colombian goods enter the U.S. duty-free.
- This agreement will eliminate tariffs on U.S. goods sent to Colombia - leveling the playing field for U.S. workers.

Support our key ally and friend in South America

- Agreement will promote U.S. security interests and support a friendly nation in a difficult region with rogue leaders like Castro and Chavez.



"Made In America" Shouldn't Mean More Taxes

Trade with Colombia today is unfair to U.S. workers. For example:

- Colombia exports 80% of its cut flowers to the U.S. with no tariffs imposed.
- U.S. exports fertilizer and flower seeds to Colombia which face significant tariffs under the current rules.

Democrats changed the rules in the middle of the game, delaying a vote to implement the U.S. – Colombia Trade Agreement which has:

- Added almost a billion dollars in tariffs on U.S. goods going to Colombia while most Colombian goods enter the U.S. duty-free.
- Hurt American workers in the manufacturing, farming, electronics, energy, and high tech industries who would benefit from the agreement.
