

Christine Clifford

Diagnosed with cancer at the age of 40 and at the peak of her near legendary sales career with Procter & Gamble, Christine Clifford was unprepared to be diagnosed with the same disease, breast cancer, that killed her mother at the age of 42. Christine turned to humor for strength and overcame the disease. Christine used this philosophy of laughter as medicine, and wrote a series of award winning books: *Not Now...I'm Having a No Hair Day*, *Our Family Has Cancer, Too!*, and *Cancer Has Its Privileges*. The success of these books lead to the creation of "The Cancer Club," the world's largest source of inspirational, comforting, and humorous products for people and families dealing with cancer. Christine lives in Minneapolis, Minnesota with her husband and six children.
