- \$23.3 billion for No Child Left Behind
- \$12.7 billion for Disadvantaged Students
- \$90 billion for Higher Education Programs, including a record \$13 billion for Pell Grants
- \$828 million for TRIO
(Designed to support disadvantaged students)
- \$303 million for GEAR UP
(Assists low-income middle & high school students achieve college scholarships)
- \$11.7 billion for Special Education
- \$215 million for Grants to Charter Schools
- \$6.8 billion for Head Start
