

Submit the application with your resume, a short statement outlining political issues of importance to you and three letters of recommendation.

All internships are paid.
Students may arrange to receive college credits.

Interns are responsible for their own housing.
Sen. Roberts office will supply a list of available intern housing in the WDC area.

Sen. Roberts' interns come from all over the country, but preference is given to residents of Kansas and former residents, who have completed their Junior year of college and are planning to return for their Senior year.
